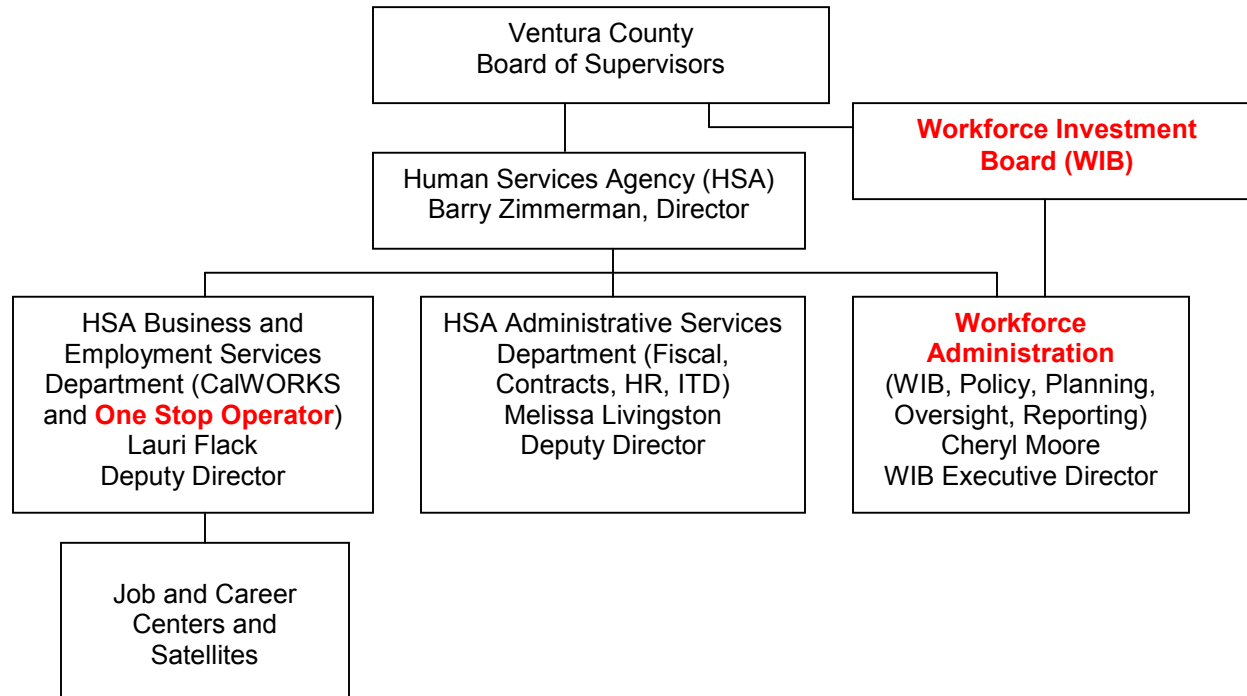


GOVERNANCE AND ONE-STOP SYSTEMS

Local Workforce Investment Area (WIA): Ventura County, California



One-Stop Operator Responsibilities:

- Develop and coordinate One-Stop program and service delivery
- Facilitate system of inter-agency referrals
- Oversee partner agency maintenance
- Coordinate referral of training programs
- Maintain One-Stop Job and Career Centers and satellite operations
- Link youth and adult training systems through One-Stop operations
- Provide program, service, and performance updates and outcomes to the WIB and Workforce Administration

Workforce Administration Responsibilities:

- Develop and oversee WIA budgets
- Develop local workforce area job training plan
- Evaluate local workforce area training providers
- Evaluate the One-Stop Operator and System
- Develop MOUs with partners
- Oversee contracts for youth, adult, dislocated worker and rapid response services and for special projects
- Negotiate and establish local performance measures
- Coordinate workforce investment activities with economic development strategies
- Seek alternative funding
- Provide guidance and staff support for the WIB
